BOSP TOTS

Our inclusive morning baby and toddler group for children up to 5 years and their parents, carers or grandparents. It provides peer support and an opportunity to receive help and advice from specialist staff, while children learn social skills, fine motor skills, structure and sharing.

Tuesdays 10.00am to 11.30am at BOSP's Skills for Life Centre.

INDIVIDUAL SENSORY SESSIONS

Individual sensory sessions for children and young people whose health needs precludes them from attending a group session or for children who are overwhelmed at being in a group session.

Tuesdays 12.45pm to 1.15pm, 1.30pm to 2.00pm or 2.15pm to 2.45pm at BOSP's Skills for Life Centre.

SATURDAY CLUB

Social and educational club with mostly one-to-one support for children and young adults 4 to 25 years. Activities can include sensory rooms, soft play, sports, inclusive gym with wheelchair swing, adventure playground, bouncy castle, crafts with a weekly theme.

Saturdays 10.00am to 3.00pm at the Pioneer School, Basildon.

LET'S CONNECT

The next step on from Saturday Club aimed at children and young adults 11 to 25 years, who are ready to socialise out in the community and learn life skills such as road safety, money handling, budgeting and eating out.

Saturdays 10.00am to 3.00pm at the Pioneer School, then leave for community activities.

HOLIDAY CLUB

Social & educational club with mostly one-to-one support for 4 to 25 year-olds. Activities can include, sensory rooms, soft play, sports, inclusive gym and wheelchair swing, adventure playground, bouncy castle, crafts with a weekly theme and music therapy.

Summer, Easter and Christmas holidays and some half terms 10.00am to 3.00pm at the Pioneer School, Basildon.

HYDROTHERAPY

Sessions are held at the Pioneer School on Saturdays and during the School Holidays. Specialist Disability Life-Savers and Spotters support the children and young people in the pool.

The warm water combined with fun exercises can help improve movement, strength and relax muscles.

HOLIDAY CLUB OUT & ABOUT

Providing mostly one-to-one support, BOSP delivers a wide range of stimulating social activities out in the community for children 4+ years during the holidays. Activities include Woodland Warriors, Sea Life Centre, farms and zoos.

Various days and venues 10.00am to 3.00pm.

FOREST FUN DAYS

Activity days based in a woodland setting with mostly one-to-one support, for 8 to 25 years. Children and young people get the chance to enjoy the fresh air and take part in exciting indoor and outdoor activities, including archery, water zorbing, wall-climbing, woodland trails, craft, pizza making, animal therapy, music therapy and party entertainers.

Summer, Easter, Christmas holidays and some half terms 10.00am to 3.00pm.

BIG BOSP

A fun youth club for young people, offering social and learning opportunities, whilst providing parents/carers with evening respite. Activities include board games, quizzes, arts & crafts, treasure hunts, outdoor games, forestry activities, shopping, meal planning and preparation.

Alternate Tuesday evenings 4.30pm to 6.45pm at BOSP's Skills for Life Centre.

CHILL ZONE

Fully supported social club for young adults aged 18 to 25 years, that takes place out in the community. It is aimed at promoting independence, through decision making, social skills and travel. Activities include theme parks, foot golf, theatre, Canal Ability, treasure trails, clubbing and meals in a restaurant.

SKILLS 4 LIFE

Bespoke daytime opportunities for young adults aged 18-25 years. Providing vital life and social skills to support their transition into adulthood and onto supported living. Activities include meal planning, cooking and washing up, house keeping, IT skills, enterprise opportunities, travel training, keeping active including swimming and trampolining, and community volunteering. Every day includes an activity that takes place in the local community.

Weekdays 9.30am to 3.30pm at BOSP's Skills for Life Centre.

Fun filled inclusive days for the whole family with woodland activities, entertainment, BBQs and refreshments.
